The following list of titles has been reviewed by the District High School Literature Selection Committee at the request of local schools. Teachers selecting titles to be studied by an entire class, to be assigned for independent reading, or to be read aloud or heard on tape, must make their selections only from this approved list. For independent reading, students may select their own material from school media centers, public libraries, bookstores or other sources under the direction of their parents. Self-selected materials are not reviewed by the district committee. Elementary and middle school teachers may not use any selection on this list for class study or to be read aloud.

Books appearing on the high school list were approved by a vote of the committee. Decisions for selecting literature from this list to support the core curriculum is the responsibility of local schools under the direction of the principal. Any student or parent concern regarding literature assigned or taught by the school should be addressed directly to the principal. According to Board policy, no student is required to read a book that he or she finds objectionable.

Grade levels that appear in parenthesis after each title are recommendations based on the content of the book or indicate the grade in which those books have traditionally been taught. Teachers wishing to teach a book contrary to recommendation should consult their department colleagues and/or school administration.

Note that Lexile measurements of novels have been included when possible. A caret sign (^) indicates that title does not have a published Lexile measurement, but "NP" indicates that the book was not written in prose - a play or free-verse format, for example. A range of levels reflects the publisher's inclusion of an introduction and/or analysis. Although some specific titles have not been analyzed thus providing a clue to the possible level of the title in question. Further information can be found Lexile.com.
