Other Factors

- If you have private insurance, in some cases, you may still qualify for Medicaid.
- If you have a child with a significant physical or mental problem you may qualify.
- If you have a large family and one income you may qualify.
- If you have family members on prescription medication you may qualify.
- At 18 yrs. or older, students may qualify for Medicaid//CHIP/SSI without counting parent's income.

Our office will assist families in accessing school and community resources. All families with financial needs are encouraged to apply for either Medicaid or CHIP. **Parents determine whether or not they choose to participate.**
